

Preparing for your visit to the Imaging Center



Wear a face mask

especially in the imaging center for your own protection and that of others. Avoid removing until at home. As precautionary step, take an extra mask with you.



Physical distance

It's best if you go alone to the center, but if you do need help, inquire about having one person with you.



Use hand sanitizer

or wash your hands on entering and leaving the center.



Ask how you will find about your results

Results may take longer than normal, before leaving the imaging center ask when you can anticipate your results.



Avoid touching surfaces

as much as possible and especially your face.



Carefully remove your mask

After your visit or when you get home, carefully remove your mask. Try to not touch the outside of the mask.



Discard or wash your mask as applicable, wash your hands, sanitize the soles of shoes and wash your clothes. This helps to reduce spread of risks of infection.
